## City of Salisbury to Offer Official Sister-City Press Conference

*Mayors of Salisbury, North Carolina and Salisbury, England, to Address the Media following Special Joint City Council Meeting and Reception*

Salisbury, NC –September 27, 2006 – The City of Salisbury has announced that a joint press conference, featuring the Mayors of Salisbury, North Carolina and Salisbury, England will be held on Thursday, September 28 at approximately 4 p.m., in the first floor conference room of Salisbury City Hall, 217 S. Main Street. The media opportunity will immediately follow a Special Joint City Council meeting and reception, scheduled to convene at 3 p.m. in City Hall's Council Chambers.

Media representatives, covering the Special Joint City Council Meeting, held in council chambers, are asked to have cameras in place by 2:45 pm. The City respectfully requests that cameras not be placed in front of the chamber audio/recording booth, to allow City staff the opportunity to operate equipment properly.

Media representatives, covering the Press Conference, tentatively scheduled for 4 pm, are asked to please set up equipment in the first floor conference room by 3:50 pm. Mayor Susan Kluttz of Salisbury, North Carolina and Sister-City Mayor Sheila Warrander of Salisbury, England will address the media at the beginning of the session. Immediately following their individual statements, the Mayors will be available for questions from the media. The City sincerely thanks the media for allowing the Mayors to greet and interact with the public during the reception time, prior to the press conference.

The press conference is held in conjunction with the six-day visit, of a 12-member contingent from Salisbury North Carolina's official Sister-City. The delegation includes the Salisbury, England Mayor and several councillors.

Additional media opportunities available to the public, beginning on September 29 include, a "parade" through Downtown Salisbury and official welcome in front
